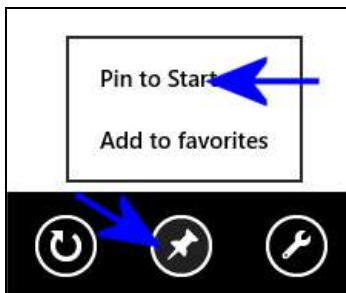
I do not see any star or other indicator to lead me to Favourites.

Windows 8 has two separate versions of Internet Explorer and they do not share any information (completely separate and independent programs). In fact, the App version can't even run Flash Player.

App Version

The app version stores favorites as tiles on the start screen which can make for a very cluttered start screen.

1. Once you have the page you want to bookmark, click "Pin" icon then "Pin to Start".



2. You have the option of typing in your own name (title) and then click "Pin to Start".



3. To go to a page or delete a favourite, click on the address bar. Scroll left and right until you see the favorite you want to go to or remove, right click and click either "Open in new tab" or "Remove".





Windows 8 Q&A

Desktop Version

The method is the same as with Internet Explorer 9. Go to the Desktop App, click Internet Explorer, and click the yellow star in the top right corner.

The rest of the process is the same as previous versions of Internet Explorer.
