



## Running SUPERAntiSpyware

This document will guide you through the process of running SUPERAntiSpyware.

**Step 1:** Double-Click the “**Security**” icon on the desktop.



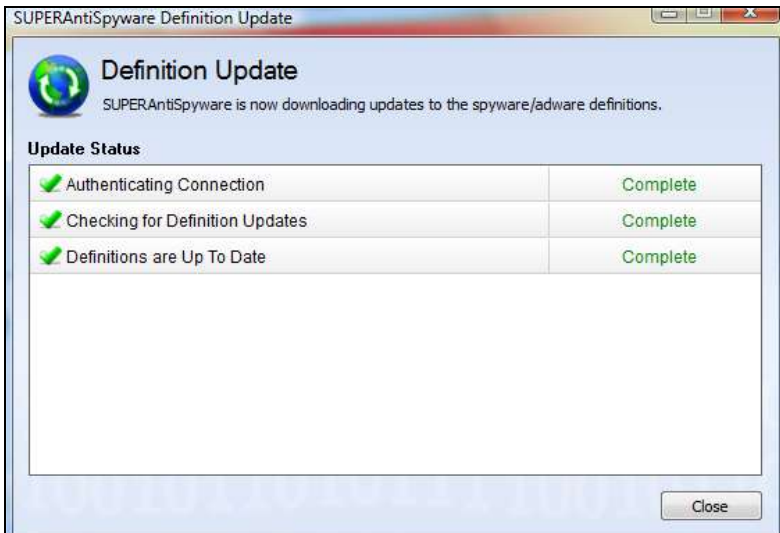
**Step 2:** Double-Click the “**SUPERAntiSpyware Free Edition**” icon and close this window.



**Step 3:** Check for updates.



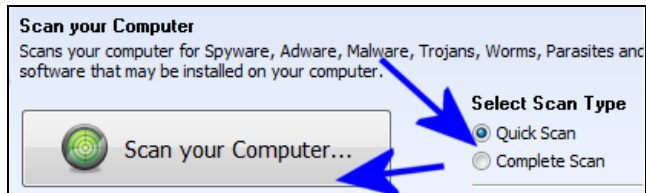
**Step 4:** Update the definitions by clicking “**Check for Updates**”. If you are asked to install the updates, click the appropriate button.





## Running SUPERAntiSpyware

**Step 5:** Select Quick Scan or Complete Scan (Complete should be performed once a month) and click “Scan your Computer...”.



**Step 6:** The scan begins and the items are displayed below “Scanning Process”. The white box below that is used to display the threats found and how many of each type were detected (Adware.Tracking Cookie shown below). Cookies are not an actual threat as they are designed to enhance the online experience by saving your information regarding a specific website.

“Memory Items”, “Registry Items”, and “File Items” are considered actual threats and need to be removed. The “Threats Detected” will indicate the total number of threats found on your system.



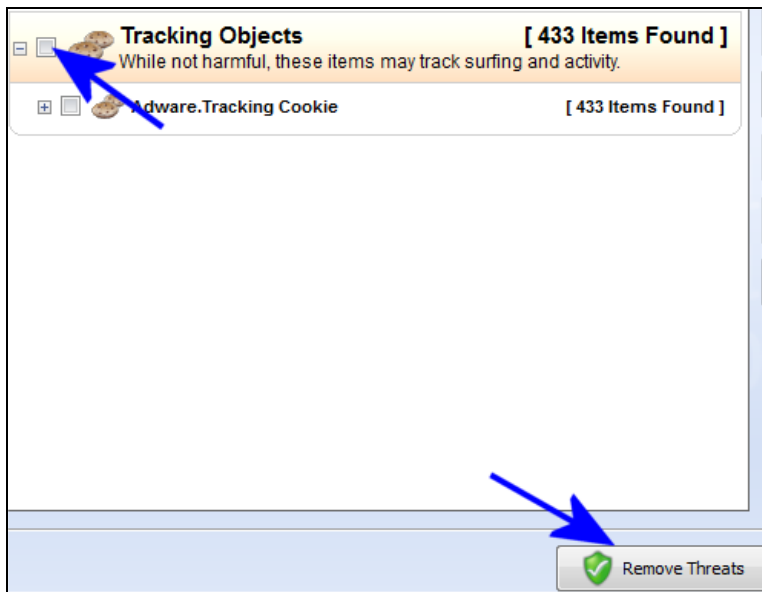


## Running SUPERAntiSpyware

**Step 7:** Once the scan is complete, the following screen will appear, click "**Continue**".

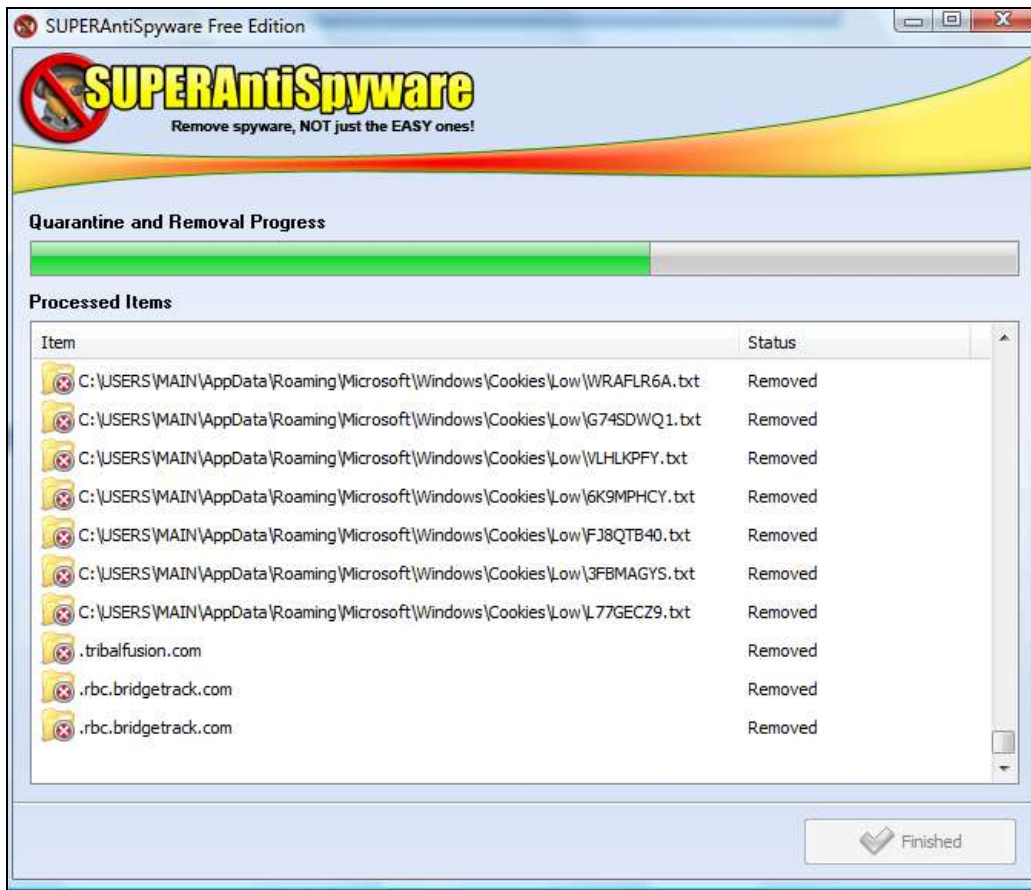


Quarantining places the infected files into a "safe" area on your system where they can no longer be harmful.

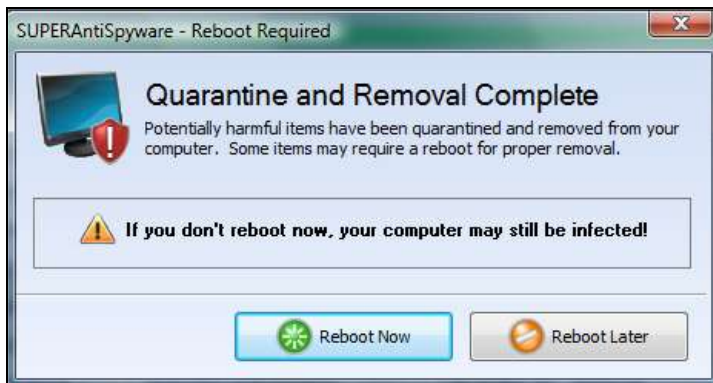


When the removal process has completed, click "**Finished**".

You may be asked to reboot your computer, if so then click **"Reboot Now"**.





## Running SUPERAntiSpyware

**Step 8:** Empty the quarantine area. This step is optional and can only be done occasionally (best to perform this step after the Complete Scan. Click "**Manage Quarantine**").



Click "**Delete All**" and then you can close the program.
